Liaoning, a land brimming with vitality and opportunities, sincerely welcomes friends from all over the world with open arms and great enthusiasm. Here, history intertwines with modernity, and tradition harmonizes with innovation, revealing boundless potential for development. To ensure that international friends can work, live, study, and start businesses in Liaoning as conveniently and comfortably as the locals, we have diligently designed and launched a series of thoughtful facilitation measures. Our commitment is to create a warm, friendly, and efficient environment for all who come to Liaoning, providing ample space for growth and development.

I. Convenient Visa Application

To further promote personnel exchanges with other countries, China has gradually implemented a number of policies, including expanding the scope of visa-free countries and the reasons for visa exemption, as well as streamlining visa application procedures.

(I) Visa-free visit to Liaoning

As of December 2024, China had reached comprehensive mutual visa exemption agreements with 25 countries (for more details, please refer to the website of China Consular Affairs: <http://cs.mfa.gov.cn>). The country had also implemented a unilateral visa-free policy for 38 countries (for more details, please refer to the website of China Consular Affairs: <http://cs.mfa.gov.cn>) and a visa-free transit policy for 54 countries (for more details, please refer to the official website of the National Immigration Administration: <http://www.nia.gov.cn>). Furthermore, China had signed mutual visa exemption agreements with 157 countries, covering different types of passports. (See Attachment 1)

(II) Application for five-year multiple-entry visa to Liaoning available for business people

On January 3, 2025, the Foreign Affairs Office of the People's Government of Liaoning Province announced plans to facilitate special visa application for foreign business people visiting the province (for more details, please refer to the official website of the Foreign Affairs Office of the People's Government of Liaoning Province: <https://wsb.ln.gov.cn/wsb/index/index.shtml>). Foreign business people visiting Liaoning for business activities, along with their spouses and children, can apply for a PU/TE Invitation Letter from the foreign affairs departments across the province through their employers. This letter facilitates the application for a multiple-entry visa with a validity period of entry of up to five years and a stay period of up to 180 days. With the PU/TE Invitation Letter, they can apply for an M visa or equivalent Chinese visa that allows multiple entries within five years and a stay period of up to 180 days at Chinese embassies and consulates abroad.

(III) Application of port visa to Liaoning

Foreign nationals arriving in Liaoning for non-diplomatic official activities—such as business cooperation, visits and exchanges, investment and entrepreneurship, visiting family members, or handling private affairs—who do not have time to obtain visas abroad can apply for port visas from the port visa granting offices authorized by the exit and entry administrations of public security organs in the province (the designated locations for applying for port visas include: Shenyang Taoxian International Airport, Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport, and the service centers of exit and entry administrations of public security organs in Shenyang and Dalian). (IV) Application of visas to Liaoning

Foreign nationals who are not eligible for China's visa-free policy can conveniently apply for Chinese visas at Chinese embassies and consulates abroad. Chinese visas are categorized as diplomatic, courtesy, official, and ordinary. (See Attachment 3)

II. Convenient Customs Clearance at Liaoning Ports

To enhance the entry experience for foreign nationals visiting Liaoning, the border inspection authority of the province has implemented several measures. Notably, self-service terminals have been installed at the border inspection sites in Shenyang Taoxian International Airport and Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport to assist with the completion of arrival and temporary arrival cards. Additionally, the authority has introduced facilitation services to create a more welcoming and efficient environment for foreign visitors, including optimizing border inspection procedures and streamlining consultation channels.

Foreign nationals can utilize self-service terminals at border inspection sites to scan their valid exit-entry documents and complete their arrival cards. Foreign visitors eligible for the 240-hour visa-free transit policy, holders of APEC Business Travel Cards, and diplomatic personnel can enjoy expedited border inspection procedures. III. Convenient Arrival in Liaoning

(I) Convenient international flights to Liaoning

Liaoning has 27 direct passenger air routes connecting with 10 countries. (See Attachment 5)

(II) Convenient access to Liaoning by international passenger Ship

Dalian Port has launched international passenger and cargo routes from Dalian to Incheon and now accommodates international luxury cruise ships from countries such as those in Europe, the United States, and Japan.

(III) Convenient access to Liaoning by air, train and road

For foreign visitors entering China through ports outside Liaoning, traveling to Liaoning is also very convenient.

IV. Convenient Handling of Residence-related Affairs

(I) High-quality and efficient one-stop services for foreign nationals in Liaoning

The immigration affairs service centers in Shenyang and Dalian have introduced a new "one-stop" model of foreign-related services. By innovatively integrating various fields, departments, matters, and networks, this model enables the "one-time" processing of matters related to foreign nationals' study, work, and residence at "one window" and through "one network". Furthermore, high-quality and efficient social services have been launched for international friends, including policy consultation, support for innovation and entrepreneurship, stay/residence permits, legal aid, and guidance for daily living. (II) Visa and residence permit application procedures for foreign nationals in Liaoning

The exit and entry administrations of public security organs in various cities provide stay and residence permit issuance services for foreign nationals, as well as green channel services for foreign experts introduced by enterprises and public institutions. Through the 12367 Service Hotline of the National Immigration Administration, these

departments provide 24/7 manual consultation services about immigration management in Chinese, English, Russian, Japanese, and Korean for foreign nationals in China. (See Attachment 7)

V. Convenient Employment in Liaoning for Foreign Talent

Liaoning extends a warm welcome to talent from around the world to work in the province. We have relaxed employment application requirements and enhanced work convenience. (To apply online, please log in to the Service System for Foreigners Working in China at <https://fwp.safea.gov.cn/lhgzweb/>)

Domestic foreign nationals can directly apply for work permits. Relevant departments may relax conditions such as age, work experience, and the validity period of work permits to varying degrees. The scope of application of the Confirmation Letter for Foreign High-End Talent has been expanded, allowing recognized foreign talent to apply for this confirmation letter (talent visa) with an extended validity period of up to 10 years.

The application, extension, change, and cancellation of work permits for foreign nationals in Liaoning can be handled through the Service System for Foreigners Working in China. After entering China, foreign nationals can download the Electronic Social Security Card App on their mobile phones to access the electronic social security cards that include their work permit information. This allows them to enjoy services such as business information inquiry and subsidy collection. (See Attachment 8)

VI. Convenient Payment in Liaoning

In recent years, mobile payment in China has developed rapidly. This service has permeated nearly all aspects of daily life, including dining, accommodation, transportation, travel, shopping, entertainment,

and medical care. This shift has liberated customers and merchants from the need for cash or POS machines but introduced certain payment challenges for the elderly and foreign nationals in China.

To address these challenges, Liaoning Province has vigorously promoted the common development and mutual complementarity of various payment methods, including mobile payment, bank cards, and cash payment, and established high-standard payment service demonstration zones. The goal is to comprehensively improve the quality and efficiency of payment services, and better meet the diversified payment service needs of the elderly and foreign nationals in the province. Liaoning has launched services such as "binding overseas bank cards with Chinese mobile payment apps" and "using overseas wallet apps for domestic payment" for foreign nationals in the province. Between May and December 2024, these services facilitated a total of 1,097,900 transactions, with a total transaction amount reaching RMB 181,714,800.

(I) Convenient payment with overseas bank cards

By the end of December 2024, a total of 18,611 key merchants throughout the province had upgraded their POS machines to accept overseas bank cards, achieving a 100% coverage rate for such acceptance among key merchants. This initiative encompasses essential scenarios such as dining, accommodation, transportation, travel, shopping, entertainment, and medical care. These merchants are now equipped to process payment using VISA, Mastercard, and other international cards.

(II) Convenient mobile payment

Foreign nationals can use the Alipay app to obtain a bus QR code for taking buses and the metro in Shenyang. Simply scan the QR code to

access these services. With valid identity documents, they can access medical services through WeChat mini programs at 12 major grade-A tertiary hospitals in the province, including The First Hospital of China Medical University and Shengjing Hospital of China Medical University. The two payment service scenarios initially launched by Alipay now encompass all aspects of travel, consumption, and daily life for foreign nationals in China. The first service is "binding overseas bank cards with Chinese mobile payment apps". The service allows users to make payments by scanning QR codes at over tens of thousands of merchants in everyday scenarios such as dining, entertainment, and shopping. It supports bank cards from six major international brands: VISA, Mastercard, JCB, DinersClub, Discover, and UnionPay International. The second service is "using overseas wallet apps for domestic payment". Users of 13 overseas wallet apps from 10 countries and regions can conveniently pay merchants in China by directly scanning Alipay QR codes. The supported wallet apps include AlipayHK (Hong Kong SAR, China), Kakao Pay (Republic of Korea), Touch 'n Go eWallet (Malaysia), MPay (Macao SAR, China), TrueMoney (Thailand), Toss Pay (Republic of Korea), NAVER Pay (Republic of Korea), Hipay (Mongolia), OCBC (Singapore), Changi Pay (Singapore), Nayapay (Pakistan), Kaspi (Kazakhstan), and Gcash (the Philippines). Tenpay has fully launched overseas bank card payment collection services, which now encompass merchants across various consumption scenarios such as dining, transportation, supermarkets, hotels, and tourism ticketing. The business supports multiple payment methods, allowing users to either scan QR codes or be scanned, and is continuously expanding consumption scenarios such as WeChat mini programs and In-Apps. This ensures a wide acceptance of overseas cards and guarantees

convenient mobile payment experiences for foreign nationals in China.

(III) Convenient cash payment

Business entities in Liaoning engaged in selling goods or services, as well as collecting fees across various sectors—including dining, accommodation, transportation, travel, shopping, entertainment, and medical care—that make collections in person all accept cash payments. All bank outlets have introduced standardized and customized "Change Purse" services, which guarantee the needs of foreign nationals in the province for immediate exchange of small-denomination currency.

(IV) Convenient foreign currency exchange

Liaoning has 2,807 bank outlets, 84 foreign currency exchange institutions, and 12 self-service foreign currency exchange machines. Additionally, there are 11,223 ATMs that support cash withdrawal using overseas bank cards and 3,873 ATMs that are available for small note withdrawals. (V) Convenient payment options available in payment service demonstration zones in key locations

Payment service demonstration zones have been set up at Shenyang Taoxian International Airport, Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport, Dalian International Cruise Terminal, and Dalian Railway Station. (See Attachment 10)

VII. Convenient Transportation in Liaoning

(I) Convenient use of certificates

The ticketing and check-in systems, as well as the terminal equipment at bus passenger stations above the second level and port passenger stations in the province, have been comprehensively upgraded. Foreign nationals can purchase tickets at passenger station ticket

windows, online ticketing platforms, mobile apps, and other channels using valid identification, such as passports and foreign permanent resident ID cards.

(II) Convenient public transportation

1. All cities and districts in the province have achieved urban public transportation connectivity with the launch of T-Union cards. Foreign nationals can purchase tickets using cash, UnionPay cards, local apps, or mobile QR code payment options, including Alipay, WeChat, and Cloud Quick Pass.

2. Public service information systems have been established in various cities and districts of the province. Foreign nationals can access real-time information on bus locations, estimated wait times, and more through the "Chelailai" bus tracking app, WeChat official accounts, local bus travel apps, and other platforms.

3. Foreign nationals can apply for T-union cards at major transportation hubs, including Shenyang Railway Station, Shenyangbei Railway Station, and Dalianbei Railway Station. These cards can be used for metro or urban bus travel. Twenty metro stations in Shenyang (see Attachment 11) and all metro stations in Dalian support ticket purchases using bank cards issued in China and five international cards including VISA, Mastercard, American Express, Diners Club, and JCB, as well as WeChat and Alipay. Metro stations support the convenient entry by swiping Cloud Quick Pass or scanning metro QR codes at the fare gates.

4. Foreign nationals can conveniently use online car-hailing platforms and integrated services such as Didi Chuxing and AutoNavi in various cities to book rides and make payments online.

5. Foreign personnel can pay taxi fares using cash as well as

mobile QR code payment options such as WeChat and Alipay.

VIII. Convenient Communications in Liaoning

(I) Support for using foreign SIM cards in China

Users of foreign operators who have roaming agreements with Chinese telecom companies can enjoy roaming services in China using their foreign SIM cards. Currently, Chinese telecom providers have offered roaming services in over 250 countries and regions, including their associated islands.

(II) Convenient application of Chinese SIM cards

Foreign nationals can purchase SIM cards with various pricing packages tailored for short-term travel or long-term work and residency at service halls owned by China Unicom, China Mobile, or China Telecom. They can use passports or foreign permanent resident ID cards to acquire these SIM cards and make payments using RMB cash, mobile payment options, bank cards issued in China, or VISA.

IX. Convenient Medical Treatment in Liaoning

Foreign nationals can enjoy the same convenient medical services in Liaoning Province as Chinese residents do.

1. A total of 57 secondary and above public hospitals across the province enable foreign nationals to make online appointments using valid identification such as passports or foreign permanent resident ID cards.

2. A total of 41 secondary and above public hospitals in the province have equipped medical workers or volunteer translators with foreign language communication skills at their "one-stop" service centers to assist foreign visitors in receiving medical care.

3. A total of 122 secondary and above public hospitals in the province have added foreign translations to signs at entrances and exits

as well as key departments to facilitate medical treatment for foreign visitors.

X. Convenient Education in Liaoning

(I) Convenient education for children of foreign nationals

Currently, there are a total of 12 schools in the province specifically for children of foreign nationals: six in Shenyang, five in Dalian, and one in Fushun. These institutions offer education from preschool through high school, based on the education models of countries such as the United States, Republic of Korea, Japan, Germany, and Canada. They primarily use foreign textbooks and provide courses including languages, mathematics, science, social studies, sports, music, fine arts, literature, and design. Children of foreign nationals may also apply to attend accredited primary and secondary schools that accept international students. They can join classes alongside Chinese students and study within the Chinese curriculum framework.

(II) Convenient application for studying in China

A total of 54 colleges and universities in Liaoning Province are authorized to enroll international students. These institutions offer a wide range of educational programs, including both degree and non-degree courses, across various disciplines such as science, engineering, agriculture, medicine, literature, economics, and management. Foreign nationals can apply for scholarships to study in Liaoning through online platform.

XI. Enjoyable Tourism in Liaoning

Liaoning, with poetic landscapes and boundless vitality, offers breathtaking natural scenery and a diverse landscape that includes

mountains, rivers, forests, fields, lakes, grasslands, deserts, and ice. The region is home to rivers such as the Liaohe River, the Hunhe River, the Daling River, and the Yalu River, which flow tirelessly. Majestic mountains such as Yiwulyu Mountain, Qianshan Mountain, and Guanmen Mountain are adorned with towering pine trees. The province is graced with a stunning coastline that stretches over 2,000 kilometers as well as a diverse array of unique landscapes like the Red Beach and Benxi Water Cave. Liaoning is one of the birthplaces of human civilization, boasting a rich cultural history highlighted by the Hongshan culture, Sanyan culture and Liao-Jin culture. There are six UNESCO world cultural heritage sites, seven 5A tourist attractions, and 154 4A tourist attractions in the region. (See Attachment 13)

(I) Convenient package tour and self-guided tour

1. Package Tour. Foreign travelers can easily sign up for package tours in Liaoning through qualified international travel agencies operating in the province. They can also explore local package tour products using online travel platforms such as Trip.com and Qunar.com, and book options after reviewing the itinerary, pricing, and other detailed information.

2. Self-Guided Tour. Foreign nationals can use their passports or foreign permanent resident ID cards to book air tickets, hotel rooms, and scenic spot tickets through online travel platforms. They can also plan travel routes and get information about public transportation, such as buses and metro services, using digital map software such as Baidu Maps and Amap. Additionally, they can rent vehicles for self-driving trips through car rental platforms.

All hotels, inns, hostels, homestays, and bathing centers offering accommodation services in the province are available to foreign visitors.

(II) Convenient access to tourism information

Foreign travelers can obtain authoritative travel information on Liaoning from official tourism websites (the official website of Liaoning Provincial Department of Culture and Tourism <https://whly.ln.gov.cn/whly/>, for example), or explore travel notes, guides, and introductions to scenic spots in the province on tourism information websites and apps such as RedNote, Mafengwo, and Qyer.com. For real-time information and personalized recommendations, travelers can search for topics related to "Liaoning Culture and Tourism" or follow travel bloggers on social media platforms such as WeChat, Weibo, and Douyin.

XII. Promising Investment in Liaoning

(I) Convenient application for company registration

Foreign investors can apply for the establishment and modification of companies in Liaoning with their passports or permanent resident ID cards. Relevant materials only include apostilles from their home countries and do not require consular authentication. Foreign nationals who have obtained foreign permanent resident ID cards can register with the identity information verification system of the State Administration for Market Regulation to realize online identity authentication and business handling.

(II) Expanded opening-up

Liaoning has two national key pilot zones with high levels of openness: the comprehensive pilot project for expanding the opening up of the service industry and China (Liaoning) Pilot Free Trade Zone. Compared with the National Negative List, the province's Special Administrative Measures for Foreign Investment Access to Pilot Free Trade Zones feature fewer restricted or prohibited items and a wider

range of investable areas, making it more advantageous in attracting foreign investors. Liaoning holds various international exhibitions throughout the year, offering numerous opportunities for foreign nationals to invest in and conduct business within the region.

(III) Comprehensive service guarantee

The province has assigned "business service personnel" to various foreign enterprises. These personnel offer 24/7 support, coordinating and resolving operational challenges these businesses may face at any time. The authority also regularly organizes foreign enterprise round-table meetings to stay informed about their production and operations and to maintain regular communication among them, government agencies, and foreign business associations.

Attachment 1

Information on Chinese Visa-free Policy

(I) Visa exemption

1. Foreign nationals holding ordinary passports from the 25 countries that have signed comprehensive mutual visa exemption agreements with China can enjoy visa-free entry into the country (for more details, please refer to the website of China Consular Affairs <http://cs.mfa.gov.cn>).

The 25 countries are:

Asia (9): United Arab Emirates, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Qatar, Maldives, Thailand, Singapore, and Armenia.

Europe (5): Albania, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, San Marino, and Serbia.

Africa (2): Mauritius and Seychelles.

Americas (7): Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, The Bahamas, Dominica, Ecuador, Grenada, and Suriname.

Oceania (3): Fiji, Solomon Islands, and Tonga.

2. Foreign nationals holding ordinary passports from the 38 countries for which China has implemented a unilateral visa-free policy can enjoy a 30-day visa-free entry into China for purposes such as business, tourism, family and friend visits, exchanges, and transit. (for more details, please refer to the website of China Consular Affairs <http://cs.mfa.gov.cn>).

Asia (4): Brunei, Republic of Korea, Malaysia, and Japan (by December 31, 2025).

Europe (32): France, Germany, Italy, Spain, The Netherlands, Switzerland, Ireland, Hungary, Austria, Belgium, Luxembourg, Poland,

Portugal, Greece, Cyprus, Slovenia, Slovakia, Norway, Finland, Denmark, Iceland, Andorra, Monaco, Liechtenstein, Bulgaria (by December 31, 2025), Romania (by December 31, 2025). Croatia (by December 31, 2025), Montenegro (by December 31, 2025), North Macedonia (by December 31, 2025), Malta (by December 31, 2025), Estonia (by December 31, 2025), and Latvia (by December 31, 2025).

Oceania (2): Australia and New Zealand.

(II) 240-hour/10-day visa-free transit

On December 17, 2024, the National Immigration Administration announced that ordinary passport holders from 54 eligible countries, traveling from China to a third country (region), can enter China visa-free through any of the 60 open ports in 24 provinces (autonomous regions and municipalities), and stay within the designated areas for no more than 240 hours. Visa-free transit travelers can make cross-province travels in the allowed areas for them in 24 provinces (autonomous regions and municipalities) (for more details, please refer to the official website of the National Immigration Administration: <https://www.nia.gov.cn>).

This policy is applicable to ordinary passports holders from 54 eligible countries who enter Liaoning through one of three ports: Shenyang Taoxian International Airport, Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport, or Dalian Port. These travelers are allowed to stay anywhere within the entire region of Liaoning Province (for more details, please refer to the government affairs website of the Exit-Entry Administration of the Liaoning Provincial Public Security Department: https://gat.ln.gov.cn/gat/jffw_141458/gatjz fz/Ingacjzww/)

The 54 countries eligible for the 240-hour visa-free transit policy are:

Asia (6): Republic of Korea, Japan, Singapore, Brunei, United Arab Emirates, and Qatar.

Europe (40): Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Monaco, Russia, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Romania, Ukraine, Serbia, Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Albania, Belarus, and Norway.

Americas (6): the United States, Canada, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, and Chile.

Oceania (2): Australia and New Zealand.

Attachment 2

Port Visa Application Procedures in Liaoning

1. Application methods

Individuals can apply for port visas from the port visa authorities upon arrival at the ports. Tourist groups can apply for port visas through the travel agencies hired by their organizations. These applications should be submitted to the port visa authorities or the exit and entry administrations of municipal public security organs.

Before the applicant arrives at the port, the inviting entity or individual may submit an application on their behalf to the local port visa authority or the exit and entry administration of the municipal public security organ. If the application is submitted to a non-local port visa authority on behalf of the applicant, it can be transferred through the exit and entry administration of the local public security organ at the municipal level or higher.

2. Application materials

For individual applications, the applicant shall submit a valid passport or other international travel documents, fill in a port visa application form, submit personal photos that meet specified requirements. The applicant is also required to present an invitation letter as well as supporting materials that state the matters for urgent entry or present the invitation letter provided by a travel agency.

When filing a port visa application on behalf of a foreigner, the inviting entity or individual shall submit a duplicate of the applicant's passport or other international travel documents as well as the invitation letter and supporting materials relevant to the matters for urgent entry.

The originals of relevant certificates shall be submitted for

review, and photocopies will be kept.

Attachment 4

Procedures for Customs Clearance into Liaoning

1. Operation procedures of self-service terminals for foreign nationals entering Liaoning. The border inspection authority has set up self-service terminals at the border inspection sites in Shenyang Taoxian International Airport and Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport to assist with the completion of arrival and temporary arrival cards. Before departing from abroad, foreign nationals can use the QR code provided on their flights to fill out entry application information. Upon arriving at the entry points of the border inspection sites, they can generate arrival cards and temporary arrival cards by scanning at the terminals. Those who do not fill out the entry application information prior to arrival can still apply for and generate arrival cards and temporary arrival cards in real-time by scanning their valid exit-entry documents at the terminals set up at the entry points of the border inspection sites after arriving at the ports. Furthermore, multilingual translation machines have been installed at the border inspection sites, and police officers have been assigned to offer multilingual translation services for foreign passengers, aiming to minimize their customs clearance waiting time.

2. Procedures of border inspection for foreign nationals. To facilitate foreign nationals who qualify for the visa-free transit policy in completing border inspection formalities, the border inspection authority has established special check and inspection areas at the border inspection sites in Shenyang Taoxian International Airport, Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport, and Dalian Port that are in line with the 240-hour visa-free transit policy in Liaoning Province. For foreign nationals coming to China for business, visits, or other purposes, the

border inspection authority may offer relevant customs clearance facilitation if they contact the responsible receiving entities or other provincial-level departments in Liaoning beforehand. Groups such as APEC Business Travel Card holders, diplomatic personnel, and passengers in need of assistance can also quickly complete border inspection procedures through specialized channels. The border inspection authority provides facilitation services at the border inspection sites, including guidance on customs clearance and assistance with inquiries related to border inspection procedures. Foreign nationals needing assistance can consult the on-duty police officers at any time.

3. Policy consultation channels. Foreign nationals in Liaoning can call the 12367 Service Hotline of the National Immigration Administration for consultation at any time if they encounter any issues related to immigration management during their stay in the province. Currently, the hotline also offers language support in Russian, Japanese, and Korean, in addition to Chinese and English. Prior to major festivals such as the National Day and the Spring Festival, foreign nationals in Liaoning can follow the "Two Announcements and One Reminder" for port customs clearance on the WeChat official account of "Liaowang Guomen", and timely obtain information about border inspection service measures and important considerations during customs clearance to effectively avoid peak hours and reasonably arrange their itineraries.

Acceptance services for foreign nationals (related to visas, residence permits, etc.): issuance of residence permits for foreign nationals working in Liaoning, extension of business visas, extension/renewal/re-issuance of visas, issuance of residence permits for foreign nationals, issuance of stay permits for foreign nationals, issuance of exit-entry permits for foreign nationals, preliminary examination of permanent residence qualifications for foreign nationals, work permits for foreign nationals in China, registration and declaration of accommodation for foreign nationals, issuance of exit-entry permits for foreign nationals, and filing of foreign-related enterprises (at public security organs).

Comprehensive services available:

(1) Agency services available at the service window: social insurance, medical insurance, housing provident fund, etc. in Shenyang.

(2) Relevant information available on the website: guidelines on the education of foreign nationals' children (inquiries about international schools), physical examinations for outbound personnel, invitation of foreign nationals to China, transnational marriage registration, medical treatment for foreign nationals, identity verification of returned overseas Chinese's relatives, identity confirmation of returned overseas Chinese's

children as examinees; entry policies for personnel from some countries to China, exit and entry policies of Chinese ports, customs policies, free trade zone policies, etc.; practical guide for foreign nationals visiting China, announcements of regular cultural exchange activities and foreign-related legal aid; provision of multilingual services.

Attachment 7

Visa Application Procedures for Foreign Nationals in Liaoning

1. Application methods

Foreign nationals seeking the extension, renewal, or re-issuance of visas and residence permits as well as stay permits shall personally go through relevant formalities and accept interviews at the exit and entry administrations of public security organs. Under any of the following circumstances, the entity or individual inviting the applicant or relatives of the applicant may submit the application on the applicant's behalf:

- (1) The applicant is aged under 16 or 60 or over, or faces mobility challenges as a result of illness or any other reason of a similar nature;
- (2) The applicant has visited China before and holds a good record of stay or residence in China;
- (3) The entity or individual inviting the applicant can cover the expenses incurred during the applicant's stay in China.

Foreign nationals who are high-level talent or whose skills are urgently needed in China and those who meet the aforementioned first circumstance may entrust eligible entities or individuals to apply for residence permits on their behalf.

2. Application materials

When applying for visas, foreign nationals shall submit their valid passports or other international travel documents, fill in the Foreigner Visa Application Form, and provide a photo that meets the prescribed requirements, along with supporting materials related to the application. The originals and photocopies of relevant certificates and documentation shall be submitted for review.

Attachment 8

Facilitation for Foreign Nationals Working in Liaoning

1. Favorable working conditions in Liaoning

(1) Direct application for work permits for foreign nationals in China. Foreign talent who enter China with valid visas or residence permits can directly apply for a foreigner's work permit in China after signing labor contracts with their employers.

(2) Relaxed age and work experience conditions. There is no age limit for foreign high-end talent (Category A) when applying for work permits in China. In principle, foreign professionals (Category B) applying for work permits in China shall not be older than 70 years old. Outstanding foreign graduates who have obtained master's degrees or above in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics from domestic high-level universities or double first-class universities can directly apply for a foreigner's work permit in China upon graduation and are exempted from the two-year work experience requirement.

(3) Extended validity period of work permits. Foreign high-end talent (Category A) can apply for a work permit with a validity of up to five years, and foreign professionals (Category B) can apply for a work permit with a validity of up to two years. Other foreigners (Category C) can apply for a work permit with a validity of up to one year. For foreign professionals over 60 years old (Category B), the validity of work permits applied for and extended shall not exceed one year. (See Attachment 8 for the description of Category A, B, and C talent)

(4) Simplified application materials. For applicants who change their employers or job positions, if they have not left China (and their work residence permits are either still valid or within one month after

cancellation), the new employers may be exempted from submitting certificates of no criminal record and physical examination certificates (applicable to applicants under 60 years old) when applying for a foreigner's work permit in China.

(5) Expanded scope of application of the Confirmation Letter for Foreign High-End Talent. Recognized foreign talent with a doctoral degree in science, engineering, agriculture, or medicine, as well as those with skills urgently needed in China, can apply for the Confirmation Letter for Foreign High-End Talent and an R visa valid for up to 10 years.

2. Convenience from the integration of foreigner's work permit with social security card in China

(1) Online application. The application, extension, change, and cancellation of work permits for foreign nationals in Liaoning can be handled through the Service System for Foreigners Working in China. Foreign nationals will not need to obtain a physical work permit once they enter China.

(2) Acquisition of electronic social security cards. After entering China, foreign nationals can download the Electronic Social Security Card App on their mobile phones and register and log in with information such as their names, work permit numbers, or social security numbers to access the electronic social security cards that include their work permit information after verification.

(3) Application for work and residence permits. Foreign nationals shall apply for Z visas at Chinese embassies and consulates abroad with their work permits in China. After entering China, foreign nationals can apply for residence permits at the exit and entry administrations of local public security organs using the Acceptance Notification for Foreigners

Working in the People's Republic of China or their electronic social security cards that include their work permit information. Exit and entry administrations can inquire about and obtain the work permit information of foreign nationals by swiping their electronic social security cards or scanning the QR codes on their work permits.

Procedures for Foreign Nationals Applying for Work and Participating in Social Insurance in Liaoning

Procedures for foreign nationals applying for work in Liaoning:

After reaching employment intention and signing labor contracts with foreign nationals in the province, the employers shall submit application materials through the national unified "Management Service System for Foreigners Working in China" according to relevant regulations on foreigner's work permit in China. The review and approval department will provide corresponding work convenience according to the relevant regulations on facilitation for foreigners in Liaoning Province.

Procedures for foreign nationals participating in social insurance:

1. Participating in social insurance. Foreign nationals or their employers can apply for social insurance registration through the online social insurance service portal or at social insurance administrative agencies with the Acceptance Notification for Foreigners Working in the People's Republic of China or their electronic social security cards. The social insurance administrative agencies shall verify the information on foreign nationals' work permits through the Service System for Foreigners Working in China and assign social security numbers to eligible individuals. The social security card management service departments shall issue physical social security cards to these individuals.

2. Enjoying the "all-in-one card" service. After acquiring physical social security cards, foreign nationals can access human resources and social security services. These services include business information

inquiries and the collection of subsidies, which can be done through both physical and electronic social security cards. The "all-in-one card" service will be expanded to cover more areas in the future, such as transportation, tourism, and cultural experiences.

Description of Category A, B and C Talent

Description of Category A, B, and C talent: foreign high-end talent (Category A): highly-skilled, sophisticated, and cutting-edge foreign talent needed for China's economic and social development, including scientists, leaders in science and technology, international entrepreneurs, and individuals with specialized or unique expertise. Foreign professionals (Category B): foreign professionals who satisfy the guidance catalogue for foreigners working in China as well as relevant job requirements and have skills that are urgently needed for Chinese social and economic development. Other foreigners (Category C): foreigners who meet the demand of the Chinese labor market and conform to China's relevant policies and regulations.

Attachment 9

Method of Obtaining the Locations of Key Outlets Offering Account Services

Foreign nationals can access the electronic map of payment services in Liaoning by scanning the QR code (shown below) using WeChat. This allows them to quickly find the locations of ATMs that accept foreign bank cards, foreign currency exchange service agencies, and key outlets offering account services for foreign nationals in China. Additionally, the electronic map offers one-click navigation, providing users with direct and convenient directions to their desired destinations.

Payment Service Demonstration Zones in Key Locations

1. Shenyang Taoxian International Airport. ① There is one bank outlet on the second floor of the terminal, which can provide comprehensive payment services for foreign nationals; ② There is an overseas guest payment service center at the international arrival exit on the first floor of the terminal, which provides services such as in-person consultations, ATM cash withdrawals, mobile payment product guidance, and publicity guide services; ③ Merchants in the dining, retail, and other consumption areas as well as VIP lounges and luggage packing areas on the first and second floors of the terminal accept domestic and international bank cards; ④ Airport shuttle buses and the metro allow payment via swiping domestic and international bank cards and also accept cash for ticket purchases; ⑤ There are three ATMs located within the terminal that support self-service cash withdrawals in 10-yuan denominations; ⑥ There are three specialized agencies in the terminal that offer currency exchange services for 35 different currencies.

2. Dalian Zhoushuizi International Airport. ① In the international arrivals hall, there is a one-stop comprehensive service center for foreign nationals, offering comprehensive convenient services such as payments, cultural tourism consultations, mobile phone SIM card sales, and transportation card sales; ② Merchants in the dining, retail, and other consumption areas, as well as VIP lounges and luggage packing areas, in the terminal accept overseas bank cards; ③ Airport shuttle buses and the metro allow payment via swiping domestic and international bank cards and also accept cash for ticket purchases; ④

There are two ATMs located within the terminal that support self-service cash withdrawals in 10-yuan denominations using overseas bank cards; ⑤ There are two specialized agencies and one self-service foreign currency exchange machine in the terminal that provide currency exchange services for 38 different currencies.

3. Dalian International Cruise Terminal. ① An overseas guest payment service center has been established at the security checkpoint of Dalian International Cruise Terminal. This center offers in-person consultations, ATM cash withdrawals, foreign currency exchange, guidance on e-CNY and mobile payment products, as well as publicity guide services; ② The ticket window of Dalian International Cruise Terminal accepts overseas bank cards; ③ There is an ATM in the terminal capable of dispensing cash in 10-yuan denominations for self-service withdrawals; ④ The terminal is equipped with a self-service foreign currency exchange machine, offering exchange services for 15 different currencies.

4. Dalian Railway Station. ① An overseas guest payment service center has been established at the exit of Dalian Railway Station. This center offers in-person consultations, ATM cash withdrawals, foreign currency exchange, guidance on mobile payment products, as well as publicity guide services; ② The ticket windows of Dalian Railway Station and Dalianbei Railway Station accept overseas bank cards; ③ Two merchants in Dalian Railway Station and 25 merchants in Dalianbei Railway Station accept domestic and overseas bank cards; ④ Each of the two railway stations has an ATM that supports self-service cash withdrawals in 10-yuan denominations; ⑤ Dalian Railway Station features a self-service foreign currency exchange machine that offers exchange services for five different currencies,

while Dalianbei Railway Station has one that provides exchange services for 16 different currencies.
